Technical problems and the effects of the corona pandemic, some of which continued, led to restrictions in the survey implementation of the microcensus in the 2020 and 2021 reporting years. The year 2020 can therefore only be compared to previous years to a very limited extent. In the years 2021 and 2022, these effects were significantly less pronounced than in the respective previous year. The failure rate was further reduced compared to both previous years. The increased immigration in 2022 is not fully reflected in the microcensus, which may have effects on the interpretation of results.
